PURPOSE:

The fire department seeks approval to accept a grant for \$5300.00 that was awarded to the fire department to purchase equipment for the engine. This equipment would be placed into immediate service upon receiving it.

BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:

It has been found in the fire department that our equipment (hoses, fans, nozzles, etc.) are aging and in need of replacement. These are basic items needed to operate at an emergency scene and need to be replaced.

On an annual basis Flint Hills offers the Helping Heroes grant to local fire departments. We were chosen to receive the grant based off of our need. This grant monies will go towards replacing some of the equipment that is in disrepair.

DEPARTMENTAL CLEARANCES:

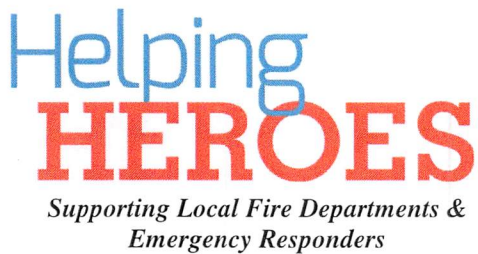
